In addition to being small, offering a fuel-efficient CVT, and having two small four-cylinder engines, the Sentra seems like it's going to be a green-mileage monster. The top trim Nismo gets 25 mpg in the city and 31 on the highway, while the base model gets 29 mpg in the city and 37 mpg on the highway. However, many competitors did even better under those conditions.
